No need to nip and tuck

which are snapping them up because of the easy way in which they deliver a selection of aesthetic technology all in one compact unit.

My five dermabrasion sessions over five weeks have completely rejuvenated my skin.

The condition is spectacular, fine lines have disappeared and people keep telling me how well I look.

Diamond microdermabrasion is a significant improvement of the micro-crystal dermabrasion.

Instead of using aluminium oxide or sodium bicarbonate micro-crystals the Dermaco Pro utilises the full benefits of natural diamond tips.

The technology allows exfoliation based on the safe and controlled removal of the epidermis, layer by layer.

While gently exfoliating the surface, the Dermaco Pro will vacuum away particles of dirt and dead skin and contain the debris in a removable filter.

Diamond tip abrasion will remove dead skin cells, imperfections, blemishes, wrinkles and any unwanted pigmentation on the skin.

Different heads and different grades of abrasive tips can be tailored to individual skin

types. At the same time, the underlying epidermis is also stimulated, promoting new collagen thickening of the dermis and improving the resistance to the effects of ageing.

After only the first treatment the results were dramatic.
