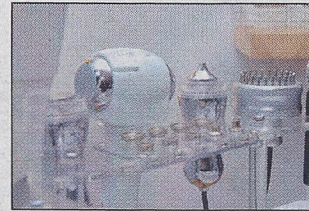

The technology allows exfoliation based on the safe and controlled removal of



the epidermis, layer by layer. While gently exfoliating the surface, the DermaCo Pro vacuums the particles of dirt and dead skin away from the target area and contains the debris within a removable filter.

Diamond tip abrasion will remove dead skin cells, imperfections, blemishes, wrinkles and any unwanted pigmentation on the skin. Different heads and different grades of abrasive tips can be tailored to individual skin types.

At the same time the underlying epidermis is also stimulated, promoting new collagen thickening of the dermis and improving resistance to the effects of ageing.

The ultrasound with collagen plumps the skin and, when combined with Biolift, lifts and tones and re-educates the facial muscles to contract, resulting in a tighter-looking skin.

At least four to six consecutive microbrasion treat-
